

Illinois Federation of Teachers CODE OF CONDUCT

The IFT Executive Board has adopted the IFT Professional Conduct Policy, which prohibits discriminatory, harassing or otherwise unacceptable behavior in the workplace and at any IFT activity, event or meeting, even if the conduct does not rise to the level of violating the law. The IFT is committed to providing a positive and respectful environment that is free of discrimination and harassment, regardless of an individual's race, ethnicity, religion, color, sex, age, national origin, sexual orientation, disability, gender identity or expression, ancestry, pregnancy or any other characteristic protected by law. We ask all meeting participants to conduct themselves consistent with the values of equity, equality and professionalism.

IFT Ethics Officer Nick Christen is the designated point person for anyone who thinks they have experienced discriminatory, harassing or otherwise unacceptable behavior at this convention.
