



Virtual March Against President Trump's Immigration Executive Orders

The AFT is participating in a “virtual march” on social media to show our opposition to Trump’s executive orders on immigration. Join us by sharing a #SolidaritySelfie on Twitter. We’re hoping to create enough momentum to make sure the Trump administration—and the media—take note of our opposition and listen to our concerns.

Here’s how to do a #SolidaritySelfie:

Show your support for immigrants and refugees by writing a short message on a piece of paper—something like “Refugees Welcome,” “Here to Stay” or “I stand with immigrants.”

Take a picture of yourself or others with the paper.

Tweet the photo, along with a note, to @POTUS. Make sure to include the hashtags **#SolidaritySelfie** and **#aftALLin**!

Here are some suggested tweets:

General:

Walls, division, bans don’t have a place in America. @POTUS seeks to divide us all.

Sanctuary Cities:

Local communities know that #immigrants are part of us. @POTUS’s executive order hurts public safety #SolidaritySelfie #HeretoStay #aftALLin

Sanctuary policies build trust between law enforcement & the people. Trust makes for a stronger & safer America. #SolidaritySelfie #aftALLin

Muslim & Refugee Ban:

Targeting Muslims goes against our core American values: freedom of religion, compassion, justice.
#NoMuslimBan #SolidaritySelfie #aftALLin
